Texas Bred/ C.A.T. Sale Futurity Show

Held in conjunction with Charolais Association of Texas "Innovation" Sale April 10th and 11th.

Entries: Entries are due at time of arrival, 8 am Friday 4/9 - 10 A.M. Saturday April 10th. All entries and registration verification must be completed no later than 10 A.M. Saturday April 10th.

Entry fee is \$50 and the animal must meet eligibility requirements.

Show heifers do not have to physically be on site until show day.

Animal eligibility requirements:

Heifer must be bred, (as listed on the A.I.C.A. registration papers) by a Texas breeder who is a current member of the Charolais Association of Texas or the Texas Junior Charolais Association of Texas.

Breeder C.A.T. dues can be paid up to 10 A.M. Saturday.

Animals purchased from an out of state breeder directly through a Charolais Association of Texas Sale are eligible.

Embryo progeny must be the product of a donor that is owned or co-owned by a Texas breeder/C.A.T. member in order to be eligible.

Any progeny resulting from an embryo purchased directly through a C.A.T. sale is eligible, but must be verified by the show committee and sale manager.

The top 5 placing heifers will have a tattoo and paper check immediately following the show.

Animals that are the result of embryo pregnancy in which the embryo was purchased from a Texas breeder are eligible; additionally the female progeny resulting from a heifer or cow that was bred at the time of purchase is eligible.

Facility details:

No pelleted bedding allowed in the facility

The only shavings allowed inside the facility are large flake suncoast shavings, we will have suncoast shavings available for purchase on site.

Outdoor carpet is encouraged.

The facility does have a low rail around the perimeter to tie cattle.

Outside pens will be available for turnout Saturday evening, only after sale cattle are loaded out.

The facility does have a wash rack and electrical plugs, generators are encouraged.

We do ask that no cattle are unloading or blowers running during the C.A.T. Innovation Sale.

Health requirements:

All animals crossing state lines must have health papers.

Show overview:

Show will be an open purebred female show.

Show will be: **Blow and Go** ; Glue, adhesive, powder, or artificial hair are prohibited.

Sheen, flair, and oils are allowed.

Exhibitors from all states are welcome to participate.

Entry fees are \$50 per head with no limit on number of entries

Prizes: Grand champion will receive \$1,500 and a banner

Reserve Grand champion will receive \$1,000 and banner

Third overall female will receive \$500 and a banner

Fourth overall female will receive \$300 and a banner

Fifth overall female will receive \$200 and a banner

All halter broke females from the 2020 Innovation Sale will be entered in the Texas Bred Futurity. The top placing female from the C.A.T. Sales will receive \$500 in addition to any money from a top 5 finish. If a 2020 Innovation Sale heifer is not in the top 5 heifers at the conclusion of the show, All 2020 sale heifers that are entered in the show will need to line up for selection as the top Sale heifer by the judge.
